Advanced Trauma Care for Nurses[®]

ATCN® Course Description

Advanced Trauma Care for Nurses® (ATCN®) was developed to teach established standards of trauma care and practical, life-saving skills. The course is designed for the experienced Registered Nurse (RN) working in a trauma setting, including pre-hospital, emergency, critical care, surgery and trauma med/surg, who wishes to increase his/her knowledge and practical skills in managing critically injured trauma patients.

ATCN[®] is taught concurrently with the Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS[®]) course for physicians. This program is offered in cooperation with the American College of Surgeons, Committee on Trauma, Pennsylvania Chapter. Benefits of ATCN[®] include an educational, collaborative, synchronized team approach to trauma care with the participants of the concurrently taught ATLS[®] course.

The course includes didactic/lecture presentations, practical skill stations, pre-test review, triage scenario discussion, scenario-based initial assessment teaching and testing stations and a written examination.

ATCN[®] Course Objectives

Upon completion of this program, the registered nurse will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate concepts and principles of primary and secondary patient assessment;
- 2. Establish management priorities in a trauma situation;
- 3. Demonstrate management priorities necessary when dealing with the trauma patient.

Participants

ATCN[®] courses are offered in conjunction with the ATLS[®] courses held at Robert Packer Hospital. Class size is limited and is based on the number of ATLS[®] participants. To allow for delivery of course materials, please register by 30 days prior to the course date.
