Heart and Vascular Center at Guthrie Robert Packer Hospital

The Heart and Vascular Center at Guthrie Robert Packer Hospital is a 17,000-square-foot, state-of-theart space for the diagnosis and treatment of heart and vascular disease, including:

- Aortic valve replacement (TAVR)
- Arrhythmia treatment, including ablation therapy for:
 - ventricular tachycardia
 - atrial fibrillation
 - atrial flutter
- Cardiac catheterization
- Coronary, peripheral, and renal artery stenting

- Internal defibrillators
- Left atrial appendage occlusion (Watchman and Amulet devices)
- Loop recorder placement
- Pacemakers
- TEE/Cardioversion

The space, which opened in Spring 2019, was designed to enhance the care provided to our patients. This design features:

- Spacious procedure rooms with state-of-the-art equipment, providing advanced images at less than half the previous dose of radiation
- Specialized 'structure-heart room' to perform both Watchman and TAVR procedures
- Capability to do peripheral vascular work
- Close proximity to the Emergency Department, ICU and ORs
- Private patient rooms for both pre- and post-procedure care
- Large waiting room with direct access at street level from the parking lot
