Criteria for Residency Achievement

Prior to receiving a certificate of completion, the resident must complete all major program requirements including successful completion of the following:

- $1) \quad \text{Completion of an exit interview with the Program Director or designee}$
- 2) Completion of required learning experience, preceptor and self-assessments
- 3) Completion of one (1) major presentation at an appropriate forum as determined by the Program Director
- 4) Submission of a manuscript suitable for publication
- 5) Completion of a major resident project.
- 6) Completion of a medication use evaluation (MUE)
- 7) Achievement of "satisfactory progress" or greater for at least 90% of all learning objectives
- 8) Scoring of "Achieved for Residency" for the following learning objectives
 - a. R1.1.1. (Applying) Interact effectively with health care teams to manage patients' medication therapy.
 - b. R1.1.2. (Applying) Interact effectively with patients, family members, and caregivers.
 - c. R1.1.3. (Analyzing) Collect information on which to base safe and effective medication therapy.
 - d. R1.1.4 (Analyzing) Analyze and assess information on which to base safe and effective medication therapy.
 - e. R1.1.5 (Creating) Design or redesign safe and effective patient-centered therapeutic regimens and monitoring plans (care plans).
 - f. R1.1.6 (Applying) Ensure implementation of therapeutic regimens and monitoring plans (care plans) by taking appropriate follow-up actions.
 - g. R1.1.7 (Applying) Document direct patient care activities appropriately in the medical record where appropriate.
 - h. R1.1.8 (Applying) Demonstrate responsibility to patients.
 - i. R1.3.1 (Applying) Prepare and dispense medication following best practices and the organization's policies and procedures.

If the resident fails to meet any one of the above objectives in 12 months, they may be granted additional time to complete the residency, according to policy Remediation & Failure to Progress Policy (RPH-D-766-004).

Completion Checklist

During the first 3 quarters, the quarterly resident evaluation will include review of status resident's progression toward meeting each element of the completion requirements. Completion checklist will be completed at the end of the 4th quarter.

Residency Program Certificate

Upon successful completion of all program requirements and compliance with all conditions of the residency program the resident will receive a certificate indicating successful completion of the residency program.

Residents who fail to complete all program requirements and/or do not comply with all conditions of the residency program shall not be awarded a certificate of completion.
